1. My dog will be kept ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES and I am able control him/her at all times.
2. My dog is not an aggressive dog and is well behaved with other dogs and is not a female in heat.
3. I will clean up after my own dog’s poop, pee, vomit....etc. and will bring my own poop bags.
4. My dog is up-to-date on vaccinations, including rabies, parvo and kennel cough.
5. We will follow all normal city and state laws regarding dogs.
7. I understand that non-compliance with these rules will result in expulsion or calling the police and/or animal control.
8. By participating in or attending this event, I agree to a global and general waiver of liability, as outlined below:

Release of Liability by Attendees-Participants-Volunteers and Vendors: “Sweet Pea Dog Parade” and all associated entities and individuals, including: Sweet Pea, A Festival of the Arts, The City of Bozeman, Working Dogs for Conservation, and West Paw Inc. Event organizers, volunteers, vendors and sponsors do not assume any responsibility for lost, stolen or injured dogs at the Event or around the Event Venue.

By bringing a dog to this Event Venue and/or participating in the Event in any manner, you do so entirely at your own risk and assume all responsibility and liability including cost and expenses in the event of any harm to the dog in your care, to other dogs, persons and to yourself.

By attending this Event should the dog in your care incur or cause any injury to any person, including yourself, other dog(s) or property as a result of the behavior of the dog in your care (or anyone else’s care) at this Event or in or around the Event Venue, whether expected or unexpected, regardless of the stimulus for the behavior (i.e., animal’s spontaneous conduct, the conduct of another animal, the conduct of any person or thing, or a combination of any of these), as the dog handler, dog owner or other and as the Event attendee, participant, volunteer or vendor you are solely liable and will be held responsible for any injury or property damage that results there from (including reasonable attorneys fees).

SWEET PEA DOG PARADE

Parade Instructions & Rules

- 1. ALL DOGS are encouraged to DISPLAY SWEET PEAS OR OTHER FLOWERS. All parade entries must be appropriate, tasteful, festive, promote the Sweet Pea spirit and parade theme. Remember this is a family friendly parade.**
- 2. PARADE ENTRY NUMBERS WILL NOT be used this year. Your dog will receive a West Paw/Sweet Pea Commemorative Bandana to wear around their neck for the parade.**
- 3. STAGING FOR DOGS BEGINS AT TBA.** Staging will occur on Main Street between 8th and 11th **DOG ENTRIES** will meet on TBA. The Children's Run starts the Parade, then the Grand Marshal will proceed and the DOGS will follow the Grand Marshal. DETAILS will be emailed to you a few after August 1. **CHILDREN'S ENTRIES** will meet on South 9th between Babcock and Main. **EQUINE ENTRIES** will meet on North 9th between Main and Mendenhall. **PARADE ROUTE:** The parade will proceed East on Main Street to Church Avenue and then disperse by heading North on Church Avenue. Please follow directions given by parade directors and police officers.
- 4. CANDY DISTRIBUTION:** According to Municipal Code 12.32.230: No participant shall throw, cast, or drop candy or any other articles. **Violation of this provision will result in a \$100 fine**, payable by the participant. Candy and other articles may be handed to spectators.
- 5. CAMPAIGNS, SPONSORSHIPS & ADVERTISING.** Political, campaign, or demonstrative content entries are inappropriate for the Sweet Pea Parade and will not be allowed. No pamphlets or promotional advertising may be handed out along the parade route.
- 6. PLEASE NO STOPPING.** No stopping along the parade route.
